Mark 1:15

Jesus said, "The Kingdom of God is **NEAR!**

Repent of your sins and believe the **GOOD NEWS!**"

The Gospel is . . .

- **The Gospel is the STORY of Jesus.**

Mark 1:1

This is the Good News (The Gospel)
about Jesus the Messiah, the Son of God.

- **The Gospel is the MESSAGE of Jesus.**

Mark 1:15

Jesus was preaching, "The time promised by God
has come at last! The Kingdom of God is NEAR!
Repent of your sins and believe the GOOD NEWS!"

- **The Gospel is the MISSION of Jesus.**

Mark 16:15

Jesus told his disciples, "GO into all the world
and preach the GOOD NEWS to everyone."

(Text the word **GOSPEL** to **33444**)

showing and telling the Good News of Jesus Everyday."***

Everyday PEOPLE.

Mark 1:17

Jesus called out to them, "*Come, follow me.*"

Romans 12:6

God has given *each of us*
the ability to do certain things well.

Everyday PLACES.

Genesis 2:15

The Lord *God placed* Adam in the Garden to work it and to keep it.

Acts 17:26

God decided beforehand *when* you should live and *where* you should live.

Mark 1:15

Jesus said, "The Kingdom of God is *NEAR*."

Matthew 28:20

Jesus told his Disciples . . . "Be sure of this: *I am with you always*, even to the end of the age."

Matthew 5:16

Jesus said, "Let your good deeds shine out for all to *SEE*, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father."

1 Peter 3:15-16

The 1 Minute Gospel.

GOD created **MAN** to love him and enjoy him forever, but man chose **SIN** and hid in the bushes of fear, shame, and blame.

God's justice required payment, but God's love came looking for Man in the bushes.

God called us out of the bushes, paid our debt with the sacrifice of an innocent and perfect lamb, and covered our shame.

Then God cursed the ground, defeated the serpent, and promised his son Jesus as the final payment for sin - our Messiah.

God sent his son **JESUS** to be born of a virgin, live a perfect life, die a sacrificial death, and rise from the tomb as our Lord and Savior.

Salvation is a gift from God that can only be received through repentance and faith in the finished and final work of Jesus on the cross.

Jesus established the **CHURCH** to gather for worship, go on mission, and share the Good News of Jesus with everyone until he returns.

Jesus came to show us the **KINGDOM** of God and will return to rule and reign **FOREVER** as the *"King of Kings and Lord of Lords."*
